

Use of Basque in the workplace of the Basque speaking population by level of education. Basque Autonomous Community (BAC)

Definition

This indicator displays the language used at work by the Basque speaking working population aged 16 to 74 years in the BAC. The working population has been classified by their level of education.

Scope

Basque Autonomous Community (BAC)

Variables and categories

- **Geographical zone:** BAC, Araba, Bizkaia and Gipuzkoa
- **Language used:**
 - Always Basque
 - More Basque than Spanish
 - As much Basque as Spanish
 - Less Basque than Spanish
 - Always Spanish

Labour Market Census (Offer Phase)

Characteristics of the source

The Labour Market Census analyses the working population in the BAC aged between 16 and 74 years.

The Labour Market Census (CMT) corresponding to the offer is included in the Basque Plan of Statistics and has been created each year since 1993 (except for in 1996, 2000, 2004, 2008, 2012 and 2016, years in which the Labour Market Census corresponds to demand).

Questions about the knowledge and use of Basque started to be included in 2008, but the questionnaire was expanded in 2017 to include the use and knowledge of Basque, not only in everyday and family situations but also at work or as a main activity.
