

Births, deaths and population development. Basque Country

Definition

This indicator reports on the number of births and deaths recorded in the Basque Country.

It also reveals the population growth: the difference between births and deaths. Population or natural development indicates the growth or reduction in the population, which is the result of the difference between the number of births and the number of deaths, without considering migratory movements.

Scope

Basque Country

Variables and categories

- **Geographical zone:** BAC, Navarre, Northern Basque Country, Araba, Gipuzkoa, Bizkaia, Lapurdi, Lower Navarre and Zuberoa.
- **Births, deaths and population development:**
 - **Births:** number of boys and girls born in a year.
 - **Deaths:** number of deaths in a year.
 - **Population or natural growth:** The difference between births and deaths (births - deaths)

Source(s)

The data is provided by the three official institutions (EUSTAT, INE and INSEE). The collection and unification of data is performed by Gaindegia (Observatory for the Socio-economic Development of the Basque Country).

Characteristics of the sources

The birth and death statistics are collected from the information provided in the **census** and **registrations** in a certain period of time.
