

The proposal, titled: “Regional” Incubators Operating in Performance-based Spaces (RIOPS), aims at improving the role of incubators for promoting an advancement in the selection, sponsoring, funding and assistance of innovative SMEs in-between European competitiveness and Regional Smart Specialisation Strategy.

The Interreg Europe finances exchanges of knowledge and best practices among EU regions, in order to implement Regional policy instruments. Therefore, they ask for Regional authorities responsible for the policies involvement (as partners or simple with a letter of support, but promising to use the project for implementing their policy tool). The EU funding rate is 85% for public bodies (or equivalent) and 75% for private institutions.
