Description of the project (summary, objectives and foreseen activities)

Project should be focus on victims of violence, and in particular:

Victims of human trafficking (men and women) in the field of migrants, asylum seeker and refugees;

Victims of domestic violence targeted in particular at the most vulnerable persons such as women and children migrants.

Project must take a migrant – centred approach with focus on the violence and exploitation (the majority of women and a lot of men) in the different steps of the migrant path. This side of the problem is hidden and based on structured internationals organization. In the same time there are the victims' needs of support, assistance and protection that are in Europe after an ordinary migration but in dangerous context with domestic violence.

Aims:

Development the knowledge about human – trafficking and migrants;

Counteract human–trafficking with support for victims without risks;

Development of working methods with support for victims and their new empowerment;

Promotion of equality respect and legality into the migrants' community;

Involvement into the migrants' community for cooperate and identify the hidden violence.

Actions:

Project is based on one or more of the following actions:

1. Capacity building:

Training for professionals who are the first points of contact for migrants, in particular for a quick understanding on human-trafficking and violence.

Training for professionals who are in daily relationship with migrants:

Managers of hospitality services;

Professionals of Governments Authorities for asylum seeker;

Professionals for integration system (helpline staff etc);

Educators and teachers who are the first point of contact for children.

Training for specialist professionals (police, medical practitioners, lawyers)

2. Activities for the victims

First helpline and legal instruments for violence supported by professionals staff;

Support group for women;

Meeting in confidence context supporting the victims in the complaint choice;

Support group for human-trafficking and violence victims with psychological help (for the development of the esteem) and practical help (empowerment in instruction and job)

Individual psychological support.
