MUSIC IN THE EU

Almost three quarters of the population from the EU listen to music on their mobile phone but very few listen to records. Other popular devices to listen to music are the computer and the tablet. Over one third still listen to music on the radio and almost a fifth on TV.

Commuting or relaxing at home are our favourite activities to listen to music, and only around a fifth need music to fall asleep. With similar percentages, around one third have music on while they're working, studying or exercising. (89 words)

MUSIC IN THE EU

People in the EU listen to music the most while commuting to work and the device they mainly use is their mobile phone. A second favourite activity is relaxing while at home, two-fifths enjoy listening to music while working or studying, and only 36% of the population do it while exercising. Apart from their mobile phones, slightly over half of surveyed Europeans listen to music on their computers or tablets, while the least used devices are the radio, the TV and vinyls. (82 words)

MUSIC IN THE EU

In the EU, almost 75% of the population like listening to music on their mobile phones. Another device which is very popular for this task is the computer or the tablet. Over one third still listen to music on the radio and almost a fifth on TV. Very few people listen to vinyls.

Most people listen to music while commuting or relaxing at home. The percentage of people who do so while working, studying or exercising is very similar. Surprisingly, almost a fifth need music to fall asleep. (88 words)
