Peter Smith likes skyscrapers, but he doesn't just like looking at them. He prefers climbing them. Last Thursday he was in Abu Dhabi, where he climbed up the Investment Authority Building, a 40 storey building. It took him nearly an hour.

The Australian Spiderman, as he is called, has climbed some of the world's highest buildings. He surprised some workers at the Canary Wharf skyscraper in London, when he knocked on the window and asked for a drink.

Peter has often been in trouble with the police, as he's usually breaking the law when he climbs things. He's been in prison. When he reached the top of the Golden Gate Bridge in San Francisco, the police were waiting for him and arrested him.

He started climbing after he saw a film about mountaineering when he was a little boy. When he was 13, he arrived home from school one day and found that he was locked out. So he climbed up the outside of the apartment block and climbed in through a window - on the sixth floor. Later, when he got bored with climbing mountains, he looked for something more dangerous.

He doesn't use any ropes or safety nets, and he doesn't wear a helmet. He just uses his own hands and feet. He's had a few accidents, and he's broken several bones, including his skull. His two little daughters and his wife have always believed in what he does.
