


Over the last decade the rate of young people dying in road accident has decreased more than 15 points

On the occasion of the celebration of the **World Day in memory of deaths in road accident**, the [Basque Youth Observatory](#) is providing data relating to the incidence of this issue among young people aged 15 to 29 in the Basque Country. These data are provided by the Department of Health of the Basque Government.

In 2013 the death rate as a result of road accident among people aged 15 to 29 in the Basque Country was of 2.1 per 100,000. Ten years before, this rate was 17.9, so we can observe that this rate has decreased more than 15 points.

There are great differences between young men and women, at the expense of men. In 2013 this rate is 4.1 per 100,000 among men and 0 among women.
