- we organised 'small groups' in Sevilla and here in San Sebastián beside the 'total programme'



#### Results 2009

- February: reaction on the Green Paper on territorial cohesion
- April, Turin: Conference on "Local Intermediate Authorities and Territorial Cohesion" with PURPLE and Terres en Villes
- June, Sevilla: Expert Meeting on renewable energies
- October, San Sebastian: This meeting on 'territorial balance'
- ... And all interesting and joyful meetings



## Evaluating 2009

- Exchange and mutual learning, worked well this year. OK
- Project development has not occurred, but is not a priority. Not OK
- Influence on European Policies: contribution on Green Paper territorial cohesion, invited to DG Regio discussions. Rather OK.

 Probable topics for 2010: sustainable transport and Future on Cohesion Policy
