Resolution on the preservation and renovation of Venice (70/22)

(Adopted by the Ministers' Deputies on 5 June 1970)

The Committee of Ministers,

Disturbed by the present situation of Venice and anxious to give evidence of the importance they attach to the preservation and rehabilitation of that city;

Sharing the concern and will to action displayed by the Consultative Assembly, particularly in its Recommendation 591;

Desirous of giving UNESCO the support of the Council of Europe member states in the efforts undertaken by that organisation at world level,

Invites member governments to make experts available to the Italian authorities with a view to contributing in a practical way to the operation of preserving and rehabilitating Venice;

Calls the attention of member states to the possibility that will be open to them, within the framework of international co-operation, of participating by means of special financial contributions in the programme for Venice.
