

Birth and death (rates). Basque Country

Definition

This indicator displays the proportion of birth and death rates in the population. I.e. The indicator displays the number of people that are born and that die per thousand inhabitants in a specific year.

Scope

Basque Country

Variables and categories

- **Geographical zone:** BAC, Navarre, Northern Basque Country, Araba, Gipuzkoa, Bizkaia, Lapurdi, Lower Navarre and Zuberoa.
- **Birth and death rate:**
 - **Birth rate:** Number of boys and girls born per thousand inhabitants in a year.
 - **Death rate:** Number of deaths per thousand inhabitants in a year.

The data is provided by the three official institutions (EUSTAT, INE and INSEE). The collection and unification of data is performed by Gaindegia (Observatory for the Socio-economic Development of the Basque Country).
