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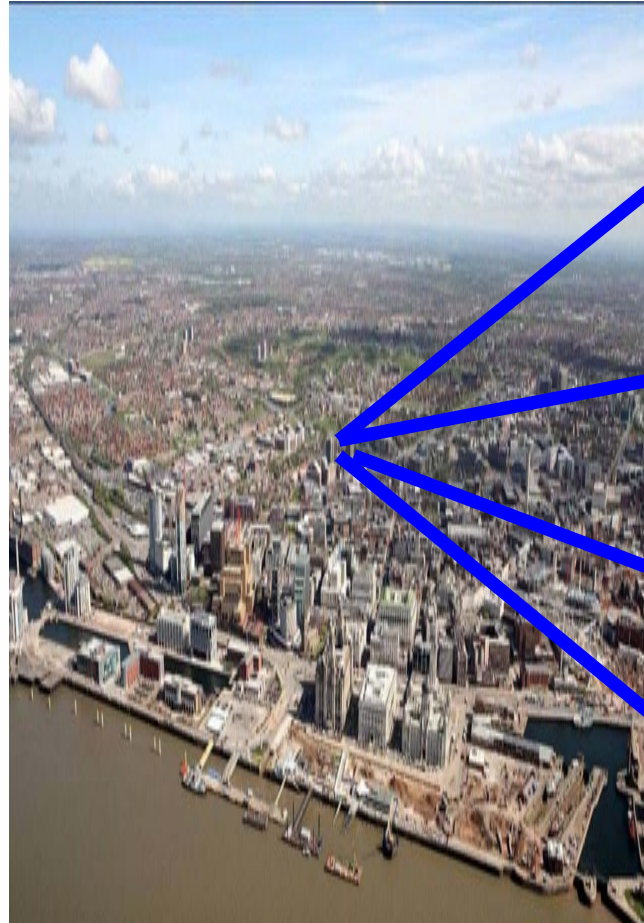

- Health Action Zone-funded tripartite project
- Targeted activity to em-bed HIA principles and practices into organisational culture.

Enablers

- High level buy in
- HIA Champions/buddies
- Not having to 'sell' the idea of HIA
- Re-structure (3 PCTs to 1)
- Local HIA network
- Partnership working



Barriers

- Definition of health
- Re-organisation
- No web site holder
- Potentially another assessment/burden
- Organisational cultural differences
- Differing priorities/timescales
- Showing the added value

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Where we are going.....

- Audit of HIAs in Liverpool
 - Which recommendations have been implemented
- Audit of HIA training-training alone does not overcome all organisational challenges
- Using HIA to link strategies together – supports the added value of HIA



Final message

- Don't give up (keep chipping away)
- Gate crash meetings (nicely!)
- This is not a failure of HIA
- It needs a plan (& try stick to it) but be creative & flexible
